FORTHCOMING HRCR MIDLANDS EVENTS

2 March JOHN HARRIS (DERBYSHIRE) TRIAL

The event is a Clubmans Permit Car Trial organised by the Vintage Sports-Car Club. The programme of the meeting will be as follows.:

- 0800hrs Scrutineering opens at Ashover Village Hall (MR 119/ 352632)
- 0900hrs Sections Open (i.e all of them)

Whilst OS Landranger Map 119 (any edition) will be needed to locate the individual sections, the following locations have been regulars in the past and likely to be used again, Both have at least two sections so make for good viewing.

- Clough Wood, Darley Dale : MR119/259619 : parking before junction of tracks as it can be difficult on the trials site itself.
- Dudwood Farm, near Elton : MR119/22856185 : private land so park in layby on B5056

Where and When : based at Ashover Village Hall, Milken Lane, Ashover, Chesterfield, S45 0BA (MR 119/ 352632). This is where you will find out the where all of the tests will be.

16 March THE JASPER'S BAKERIES AGBO HISTORIC STAGES RALLY

This year's AGBO Stages will again comprise two events run at Weston Park on consecutive days, again promoted by Owen Motor Club (OMC) and supported by Jasper's Bakeries.

The Saturday's event will be a rally open to Historic cars only and will also be the first round of this year's HRCR Mini Sport Cup Stage Rally Championship. Sunday will be for AGBO Stages Rally, one that is open to all 2WD vehicles and forming the opening round of the AWMCC Heart of England Championship.

As ever, the two events could not go ahead without volunteers and Owen Motor Club once again require radio crews and large numbers of in-stage marshals to give the coverage needed for a venue of this type, whether they have Motorsport UK licenses valid for 2019 or not. A Scenic Tour for Classic Cars in Derbyshire and Staffordshire



The HRCR Midlands Region will be organising the 7th 'Derbyshire Dales Drive' on Sunday 2nd June 2019. The route this year will spread a little wider allowing you to visit more of the open moorland sections of Derbyshire and Staffordshire. You will have the option of completing a 100 mile or 120 mile route.

The start and finish will again be at the Pavilion Gardens in Buxton, with a lunch halt at Carsington Water. Buxton provides a super venue for us and there is plenty of accommodation if you want to stay overnight.

Your coffee halt will be at the Derbyshire and Lancashire Gliding Club – if the weather is good there should be plenty of action!

The entry fee (for a crew of 2) is being held at £75. This will include breakfast, morning coffee, a picnic lunch, and buffet at the finish. A tour plate, a comprehensive roadbook, and a souvenir are also included.

Each crew will receive a souvenir digital photograph taken during the event.

Eligibility

This non-competitive event is open to motor cars registered before the 31st December 1990. Interesting later cars may be accepted at the Organisers' discretion.

All cars should be presented in good condition and the Organisers reserve the right to decline any car deemed unsuitable and/or carrying advertising, competition style numbers, or showing damage.

Each car must have a V5 Registration Document and valid MOT Certificate (where required). MSA Competition Licences are not required.

Entries

The maximum entry for the event will be 60 and the minimum 40. Should the minimum not be reached, the Organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.

The Entry List opens on 12th January 2019 and closes on Saturday 18th May 2019. If the entry list is full before the Closing Date, a reserve list will be started.

The Entry Fee is £75 per car and crew of two and includes a detailed road book, rigid rally plate, breakfast at the start, mid-morning beverages, picnic lunch box, buffet and tour souvenir at the finish. A digital photograph of you and your car will be included in the entry fee. The charge for additional passengers will be £25.00 per person.

All entries should be made on the official Entry Form (fully completed), accompanied by the appropriate fee and sent to the Entries Secretary.

The starting order will be determined by receipt of entry, unless otherwise requested at the time of making the entry.

The cost of any entries withdrawn in writing prior to 18th May 2019 will be refunded, less an administration fee of £10. Thereafter refunds will be at the Organiser's discretion.

Insurance

The event is a non-competitive touring assembly held under an MSA Certificate of Exemption. Being such, its entrants should be covered by a standard motor car insurance policy for the use of their cars on a public highway. However, if in doubt, please seek advice from your insurance company / broker.

The Route

You will have the option of a 100 mile or 120 mile route on tarmac roads within Derbyshire and Staffordshire, all as defined by a comprehensive road book incorporating tulip route instructions. No additional maps are required but, should you wish to bring your own maps, the route will be found on OS Landranger maps 110 and 119. The Final Instructions will include a Navigational Exercise and an outline route.

Places for coffee and rest stops will be available en route, whilst the lunch break will be taken at Carsington Water, near Ashbourne. A picnic lunch box will be provided at the start. However, you may bring your own picnic or catering is available at Carsington Water. At the finish (The Pavilion, Buxton) there will be a buffet meal.

As ever, please be mindful of other road users, particularly horse riders, cyclists and walkers.
