

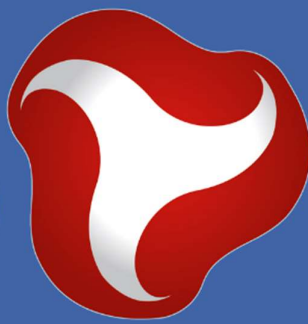


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SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS





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SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

1. ORGANISATION

The Historic Rally Car Register in conjunction with Motorsport IOM will organise a Touring Assembly on **10 August 2024**. The event will be supported by Manx Petroleum and will be known as the “Tour of Mann supported by Manx Petroleum”

The event will be held under a certificate of exemption issued by Motorsport UK.

These Regulations & any written instructions that the organisers may issue for the event.

The event has no competitive element. The Motorsport UK Event Permit number is: **TBA**

2. ELIGIBILITY

The event is open to three and four wheeled cars of any age, the more different the better. Cars must not carry any advertising/sign writing unless by previous agreement with the organisers. The display of any competition number(s) is not allowed. A driver and navigator name on the front wings is permitted.

The event is open to members of organising club(s). Members of the public are also invited to participate.

Drivers must hold a valid driving licence, although a specific competition licence is not required.

All cars must be taxed and insured for use on the public highway and carry a valid MOT certificate, if applicable.

3. ENTRIES

Entries open on publication of these Regulations, and close on **31 July 2024**.

All entries must be made using the on-line entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of **£95** for two people travelling in the car. Please add **£30** for each additional person. Each entry will be acknowledged by e-mail.

The entry fee includes:

- “Tulip” style Road book,
- one period style rigid vehicle identity plate,
- Also included for each signed on person, are a bacon roll together with tea and coffee at the start, and a hot meal at the finish.

The maximum number of cars on the event is **50** The minimum is **15**. Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organiser’s reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full. If an entrant particularly wants to run close to a friend/colleague, then this should be noted in the appropriate space on the entry form.

Entries should be made on the appropriate entry form and remitted with the correct fee.

Entry payments can be made via internet banking. Account details can be found on the entry form which can be accessed via [Tour of Mann 2024 - Internet Entry Form \(rallies.info\)](https://www.rallies.info)

Entry fees will be refunded up to the closing date of **31 July 2024** without penalty. Entrants wishing to cancel after this date will be refunded the entry fee less £20 administration charge.

A cancellation of an entry must be sent via email to the entries secretary. The refunded amount will be at the organisers discretion.

4. ROUTE

The event will start and finish at:

Babbage's Bistro & Bar, Mountain View Innovation Centre, Jurby Road, Lezayre. IM7 2DZ

The first car will leave at **10:00hrs**. The route will cover approximately **100** miles around the stunning Isle of Man.

The route will be given in an easy-to-follow Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event. Although not required to complete the route, entrants may like to follow their progress on Ordnance Survey 'Landranger' map **95**.

Along the route, there will be Check Points, and unmanned code boards to observe the entrant's adherence to the defined route. At each point the entrant's Route Check Card will be signed. These Check Points will be open for specified periods, giving adequate time to visit them while they are open.

Entrants are to be advised that whilst the majority of the route uses roads that allow two-way traffic, some roads are single carriageway and care & courtesy should be taken with regards other road users.

Whilst this is not a timed event entrants may be requested to wait at manned controls to allow the event to maintain reasonable gaps between cars.

There will be fuel stations on route, and these will be marked in the Road Book.

The organisers mileage will be deemed as correct.

5. TIMETABLE

The timetable for the event will be as follows:

6. DOCUMENTATION

Cars/Entrants must arrive at the start not later than **09:15**.

The following, plus the vehicle being used documents must be available for inspection:

- Driving License for the driver.
- V5C Registration Document. Appropriate vehicle **MOT Certificate**
- All entrants must ensure that the vehicle has a road fund licence (if applicable) and adequate insurance to enter the event.
- The driver will be required to sign a declaration to this effect at documentation.

A basic vehicle Scrutineering/Eligibility check may be carried out at the start.

Any vehicle, which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start. Cars must not display any advertising or carry any competition numbers on the doors.

After documentation, entrants will be issued with road books, rally plates and route check cards.

The Rally plate is to be affixed to the front of the car in a forward-facing position – cable ties will be provided.

All cars that have completed the prescribed route within the specified time will be regarded as a finisher.

A commemorative award will be presented to all crews.
