



# Daffodil Run

Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2025

## Regulations



### **1. Organisation.**

The Historic Rally Car Register will organise the "Daffodil Run"

A Touring Assembly on **Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2025.**

The event will be held under a certificate of exemption issued by Motorsport UK.

These Regulations & any written instructions that the organisers may issue for the event.

The event has no competitive element. The Motorsport UK Event Permit number is: **TBC**

### **2. Eligibility.**

The event is open to four-wheeled road cars first registered before 1st January 2005

Interesting later cars may be accepted at the organiser's discretion.

### **3. Entries.**

Entries open on publication of these Regulations, and close on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> March. All entries must be made using the on-line entry form and be accompanied by the entry fee of **£120** for two people travelling in the car. Please add **£30** for each additional person. Each entry will be acknowledged by e mail. The entry fee includes one Road book, one period style rigid vehicle identity plate, **Breakfast roll with tea/coffee. Morning Coffee & cake**, end of event **2 course evening meal** with a commemorative award. The entry fee will also include a carbon offset fee.

The maximum number of cars on the event is 40. The minimum is 15. Should the above minimum figure not be reached, the organiser's reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full. If an entrant particularly wants to run close to a friend/colleague, then this should be noted in the appropriate space on the entry form.

#### **4. Route.**

The event will start and finish at the:

### **The Royal Oak. Much Marcle, Herefordshire. HR8 2ND.**

The first car will leave at 10.30am. The route will cover approximately 80 miles in South Herefordshire and Gloucestershire.

The route will be given in an easy-to-follow Tulip Style Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event. Although not required to complete the route, entrants may like to follow their progress on Ordnance Survey 'Landranger' maps 162 & 149.

Along the route, there will be Check Points to observe the entrant's adherence to the defined route. At each point the entrant's Route Check Card will be signed. These Check Points will be open for specified periods, giving adequate time to visit them while they are open.

#### **5. Timetable.**

The timetable for the event will be as follows:

8.30 Signing on.

9:30 Drivers Briefing

10.30 First car starts

11.30 First car arrives at the Coffee Halt.

15.00 First car arrives at The Royal Oak.

15:15 End of event meal served.

#### **6. Documentation.**

Cars/Entrants must arrive at the start not later than **9:00 am**.

The following, including the vehicle being used documents must be available for inspection:

- a Driving License for the driver.
- b. V5C Registration Document. Appropriate vehicle **MOT Certificate**
- d. All entrants must ensure that the vehicle has a road fund licence (if applicable) and adequate insurance to enter the event.
- e. The driver will be required to sign a declaration to this effect at documentation.

A basic vehicle Scrutineering/Eligibility check may be carried out at the start.

Any vehicle, which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start. Cars must not display any advertising or carry any competition numbers on the doors.

After documentation, entrants will be given their Event Vehicle Identity Plate, Road Book, and Route Check Card. They will also receive their Coffee & Meal vouchers.
