Regulations

ORGANISATION

1. The Historic Rally Car Register will organise the 23rd "Autumn Leaves Scenic Tour", a Two-day Touring Assembly on Saturday 24th & Sunday 25th October 2026.
2. The event will be held under a certificate of exemption (Permit no) issued by M S U K, these Regulations & any written instructions that the organising club may issue for the event.

ELIGIBILITY

3. The event is open to four-wheeled road cars first registered before 1st January 2006. Interesting later cars may be accepted at the organiser's discretion.
4. All cars must hold a V5C Registration Document and have a valid MOT certificate (if applicable). Cars must not display any advertising or carry any competition numbers on the doors.
5. Any person may enter the event. All drivers must produce a valid driving licence.

ENTRIES

6. Entries open on the publication of these Regulations, and close finally on Tuesday 13th October. The entry fee of **£ 895** is for two people per car.
(This can be split into 3 staged payments of one of £295 and two £300)
There is a £15 supplement per person per night for anyone requiring a single room.
Please contact the event secretary if additional passengers are required.
Each entry will be acknowledged. Where possible all correspondence will be via e mail.
It is therefore important that your e mail details are entered clearly on the entry form.
Final Instructions (including an Entry List and directions to the Start) will be sent out during the week prior to the event.
7. The entry fee includes Bed & Breakfast & evening meals for Friday & Saturday.
All 'on event' food, and a three-course meal at the end of the event on Sunday.
A Road book, commemorative event vehicle numbered plate and an event commemorative award.

9. The maximum number of cars on the event is **Sixty**. The minimum is **Twenty**. Should the minimum figure not be reached, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event and entry fees will be refunded in full. Entries will be selected in order of receipt, the running order being decided by the organisers. If an entrant particularly wants to run close to a friend/colleague, then this should be noted in the appropriate space on the entry form. A refund less a £25 admin charge will be given to entries withdrawing before 10th October. In the event of an entry being withdrawn after the 10th, the refunded amount, will be at the organiser's discretion. (Hotel & Refreshment bookings)

ROUTE

10. The event will be based at the Metropole Hotel, Temple St, Llandrindod Wells, Powys LD1 5DY
Tel: 01597 823700. www.metropole.co.uk.
The **Metropole** is a **4 star, Luxury** Hotel in Mid Wales.
The route will cover approximately 240 miles in the Central Wales area.
11. The two-day route will be split into three sections on Saturday and Two sections on Sunday. This will be given in an easy to follow Road Book, which will be issued to entrants at the start of the event. Although not required to complete the route, entrants may like to follow their progress on Ordnance Survey 'Landranger' maps 135, 136, 146, 147 and 160.
12. The first car will leave the start on Saturday at 10:00hrs.
Sunday start will be at 10:00hrs.
Cars will then leave at one-minute intervals for road safety reasons.
Cars will leave all halts in entry list order.

13. Along the route, there will be Check Points and Code Boards to observe the entrant's adherence to the defined route. At each Check point the entrant's Route Check Card will be signed. These Check Points will have plenty of time to be visited. The code boards will be placed along the route. These are used for participant's route verification purposes only.

DOCUMENTATION

15. The following documents must be available for inspection:
Driving Licence for the driver
V5C Registration Certificate for the car being used
Current vehicle **MOT Certificate** (if applicable) for the car being used
16. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure that their vehicle is taxed and insured.
Any vehicle which, in the opinion of the organisers, is deemed inappropriate or unsafe, will not be allowed to start.
17. All entrants must ensure that they have adequate insurance to enter the event, and they will be required to sign a declaration to this effect at documentation.
The event has **NO** competitive element.
18. After documentation, entrants will be given their commemorative numbered plate, Road Book, and Route Check Card. They will also receive their 'on event' meal vouchers.
